

Tridium has announced the end-of-life (EOL) schedule for the **JACE 8000** controller.

The JACE 8000 hardware is being replaced with the **JACE 9000** hardware. This transition is set to occur throughout 2024 and 2025.

The following are important events and dates in the JACE 8000 EOL timeline:

- Niagara 4.15 is planned to launch in Q3 2024. This will be a long-term supported release and the last supported Niagara 4 version for the JACE 8000.
- JACE 8000 Last Time Buy (LTB)\* date is planned for December 2025.
- JACE 8000 End of Hardware Support date is planned for July 2028.

\*Tridium's LTB is subject to product availability.

The JACE 9000 uses the same footprint and wiring locations as the JACE 8000 to allow for easy upgrades and device replacements.

The JACE 9000's improved hardware platform optimizes the features of Niagara 4 and includes a number of advancements:

- Increased performance and capacity to leverage tagging, templating and visualization
- Quad Core processor
- Increased RAM and file system storage
- Faster startup and station load time

The JACE 9000 is supported and licensed for Niagara 4.13, which is the minimum Niagara software version that can be used in conjunction with the controller. For more information about JACE 9000 features, refer to the product [data sheet](#).
